Title: IPE/IPP/IPC: From Practice to Policy - and Back Again: Doing things right, for the right reasons

Translating research into policies for practice, is a challenge for professionals who have little or no experience of working with various levels of government - locally, regionally, federally and globally. Policy is a decision-making framework or course of action to achieve a desired effect (or change), frequently through regulation and legislation. The purpose of this workshop is to understand that framework and some key principles of policy making. Participants in the workshop will engage in small group exercises that will assist them in understanding how to move from principles to implementation. These practical exercises will demonstrate how to develop strategic approaches to policy development and interventions. The exercises will include: how to control a meeting; how to compose a strategic elevator speech; how to write a focused Op-Ed for a newspaper, and how to prioritize the elements that must be addressed in a Briefing Paper. The exercises will focus on the environments of interprofessional education, interprofessional practice and interprofessional care.
